# CHURCH CLEAN-UP DAY

Пост богоустановлен - это Божий дар, период молитвы и воздержания, время ограждения себя от всего греховного и второстепенного, стяжание Единого на потребу.

Пост это не только воздержание от скоромной пищи, но, главным образом, время выявления своих основных греховных язв и избавления от них. Церковь поучает нас: «Пост не воздержание от брашен точию совершим, но от всякия вещественные страсти отчуждение...». Увидеть свои вещественные страсти можно только чистым умом, и пост с молитвой есть лучшее средство для очищения ума. Пост это также удаление от развлечений. Жизнь наша в сей «электронный» век полна разных распыляющих сознание развлечений, крепко обосновавшихся во многих

православных домах, развлечений засоряющих души страстными образами, лишающих верных «Богодарованного времени покаяния».

В эти очистительные дни поста, дорогие братия и сестры, оставим свои развлекательные экраны, ослепляющии наш духовный взор, затворим двери чувств на все суетное, оставим вражду, споры, разделения, все лишнее, тленное и душевредное, и тогда пост для нас действительно станет Великим, и принесет нам великую пользу.

Таким образом, пройдя душеспасительную Четыредесятницу, мы сможем с чистой совестью и с ясными очами веры встретить Христа Распятого и Воскресшего, и сподобимся достойно облобызать Его Божественые раны и поклониться славному Его из мертвых Воскресению!

# GREAT LENTEN EPISTLE OF HIS EMINENCE METROPOLITAN LAURUS, FIRST HIERARCH OF THE RUSSIAN ORTHODOX CHURCH OUTSIDE OF RUSSIA

Dear in the Lord brothers and sisters, while travelling through the salvific days of the holy Great Lent, let us rejoice together with the Holy Church on the arrival of the "Godgranted time of repentance," and may we not be saddened by the arrival of Great Lent, but saddened by our own sins, for the time has come to heal them. As the Holy Church sings: "The fast is here, the mother of chastity, the accuser of sins, the advocate of repentance, life of angels and salvation of men." Lent is established by God — this is a divine gift, a period of prayer and abstinence, a time to protect oneself from all that is sinful and secondary, seeking only the One we need.

Lent is not only the abstinence from non-lenten food, but mainly a time to reveal our fundamental sinful sores and removing them. The Church teaches us: "Let us not keep the fast by merely abstaining from foods, but [let us put away from us] every material passion". One can only see ones material passions with a clean mind, and fasting and prayer are the best means to cleanse the mind. Lent is also removing oneself from entertainment. Life in this "electronic age" is full of all sorts of amusements which debilitate our consciousness; this has firmly established itself in many Orthodox homes, they are forms of entertainment that litter our souls with images of passion, which deprive the faithful of "the divine time of repentance".

During these cleansing Lenten days, dear brothers and sisters, let us leave behind our screens and monitors which blind our spiritual sight, let us close the doors of our senses to all that is useless, let us abandon enmity, quarrels, divisions, all that is extraneous,

corrupt and harmful to the soul, and then Lent for us will truly become Great, and will bring us great benefit.

In this way, passing through the salvific Forty-day Lent, we will be able with a clean conscience and with the clear sight of faith to greet the Crucified and Resurrected Christ, and will able to worthily kiss His Divine wounds and prostrate ourselves before His glorious Resurrection from the dead!

# SERVICE OF ANOINTING («CODOPOBAHNE») ON SUNDAY APRIL 17TH

The Holy Mystery of Anointing with Oil for the healing of sickness is mentioned in the Holy Bible by Saint James, the Brother of the Lord. He says, "If you are sick, ask the priests to come and pray for you. Ask them to put olive oil on you in the name of the Lord". Ideally, seven priests together perform this mystery, but it can be done by less, and even by one priest alone. In the service of Anointing with oil there are seven epistle readings (readings from the "Letters" in the New Testament) and seven readings from the Holy Gospel. The priests pray that God will bless the oil (which is usually mixed with wine) and that it will be for the healing of the soul and body of the person to be anointed. There are also prayers for the forgiveness of sins, the ultimate cause of all sickness. The sick person is then anointed on the forehead, nostrils, cheeks, lips, chest, and both sides of the hands. During Great Lent, our Russian churches have a service of general anointing in which everyone comes to be anointed for the healing of spiritual and physical sickness. This is an important part of the preparation for the celebration of Pascha. Some church writers say that this Holy Mystery in part absolves us from those sins that we have forgotten or are unaware of. All are encouraged to attend our service, scheduled for 5.00pm on April 17th. The service will take about 3 hours. This is the first time that the service of general anointing has been served in Gosford.

### CHURCH SERVICES IN APRIL

April is even busier than March, with over 20 services scheduled. Please note that the service scheduled for the morning of Monday  $25^{th}$  - the Anzac Day public holiday - has been cancelled to allow for a thorough clean-up of the church before Pascha.
